**JOINT STIPULATION
REGARDING CLAIM
CONSTRUCTION**

1 Plaintiff/Counter-Defendant Advanced Voice Recognition Systems, Inc.
 2 (“AVRS”) and Defendant/Counterclaimant Apple Inc. (“Apple”) have reached an
 3 agreement to resolve all claim construction disputes relating to the patent asserted in this
 4 case, U.S. Patent No. 7,558,730 (“the ’730 patent”). Certain definitions adopted by the
 5 parties are provided by the specification of the ’730 patent.

6 This stipulation, if adopted by the Court, will obviate the need for claim
 7 construction briefing and the claim construction hearing currently set for June 21, 2019.

8 The parties stipulate and request that the Court adopt the following constructions:

Term	Joint Proposed Construction
uniform system protocol	A protocol that processes information expressed in a normalized data format.
first protocol	A first group of processes that a User and/or an ASR employs to directly support some business process or transaction and is accessed using a Native Communications Protocol.
second protocol	A second group of processes that a User and/or an ASR employs to directly support some business process or transaction and is accessed using a Native Communications Protocol.
application service adapter	An application layer within the Speech Recognition and Transcription System that provides an interface among Users, Speech Recognition and Transcription Engines, the System Transaction Manager and other system components by allowing a User’s existing application and/or a system components application to communicate with the Transaction Manager.
user application service adapter	A specific Application Service Adapter that handles formatting and Routing of Speech Information Requests and Responses to elements of a User’s Protocol within the Speech Recognition and Transcription System.
speech information request(s)	Formatted speech, which can be acted upon by system components, including the System Transaction Manager.

response(s) to [the] speech information request(s)	A formatted transcription of formatted speech.
spoken text	Audible words.
system transaction manager	A server application that provides a central interconnect point (hub) and a communications interface among system components and Users having disparate or heterogeneous protocols; and, an information router (or bridge or switch) within the Speech Recognition and Transcription System.
speech recognition and transcription engine	A process running on a computer that recognizes an audio file and transcribes that file to written text to generate a transcription of Speech.

If the Court adopts the parties' proposed constructions, then the parties further request that the deadlines set in the Case Management and Minute Order regarding claim construction briefing and the claim construction hearing be vacated. (Doc. 32; Doc 66). These deadlines include: Plaintiff's Opening Claim Construction Brief (April 5, 2019), Defendant's Responsive Claim Construction Brief (April 26, 2019), Plaintiff's Reply Claim Construction Brief (May 10, 2019), and the Claim Construction Hearing (June 21, 2019).
